The Seminar for will take place on April 06 - 07, 2024, in Icelab ice rink, Via San Bernardino 141, Bergamo (Italy).

The goal of the Seminar is to develop the artistry of figure skating at a young age. It offers Junior & Novice skaters, the opportunity to share the ice with renowned moderators and grow their knowledge about the artistic side of our beautiful sport.







General

The Seminar is designed to deliver education on overall skating skills, choreography, technique, and the art of performing on ice for a total of 34 skaters (Junior and Novice level).

Focus of this Seminar

The Seminar will aim to:

- better understand the connection of the elements with the music and the choreography.
- develop and deepen aspects of skating skills (focus on glide, expressiveness, flow, balance, power, edge control and the vast variety of turns)
- train off-ice with innovative classes including modern ballet and other dancing activities to improve musicality and learn different choreographic processes.
- teach specific exercises to improve the expression of different emotions, interpretation of the music and many more performance skills.

Entries

The number of skaters entered from each ISU Member is limited, and a general guideline has been established of a maximum of 2 skaters per ISU Member.

If there are more entries than places available, places will be allocated by the Organizing Committee.

- The related coaches are welcome to participate to the Seminar with their skaters.
- The Seminar is also open to coaches wishing to attend without skaters involved.
- The Seminar will be conducted in English.
- Skaters and coaches are required to bring their skates and own sportswear needed for the seminar's activities.

The Entry applications of the skaters should be done by the Members and reach the organizers before Friday, March 8, 2024.


Participants should arrange to arrive on the morning of Saturday, April 06, 2024, and depart on the late afternoon of Sunday, April 07, 2024.
