Decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission

The ISU filed on October 19, 2010 with the ISU Disciplinary Commission a Complaint against Mr. Walter Toigo (ITA) an ISU Judge and International Referee for Single and Pair Skating, for alleged Violations of the Duties of Judges and the ISU Code of Ethics.

Following consideration of the alleged Violations of the Duties of Judges and the ISU Code of Ethics, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on January 10, 2011, taken the following decision:

- 1. Walter Toigo is guilty of misconduct and of violation of the duties of Judges and the ISU Code of Ethics.
- 2. A two year suspension from participation in all ISU activities as an ISU Judge / International Judge and International Referee is imposed on Walter Toigo beginning with the legal effect of this decision.
- 3. Each party shall bear its own legal and other costs

The present decision was subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), Lausanne, Switzerland, within 21 days upon receipt of the decision, in accordance with Article 24, paragraph 12 and Article 25 of the ISU Constitution 2010. No such appeal has been filed. Therefore, the Decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission has become effective as of January 10, 2011.
