Decision of the ISU Disciplinary Commission

The ISU Sports Directorate filed on April 4, 2012 with the ISU Disciplinary Commission a Complaint against Ms. Lise Rosto Jensen (NOR), ISU Judge and Referee for International Competitions in Single & Pair Skating and her sister, Ms Hege Rosto Jensen (NOR) International Judge in Single & Pair Skating for an alleged conflict of interest situation and violation of Rule 121, paragraph 3 of the ISU General Regulations and the ISU Code of Ethics, by having served as family members on the same panel as Referee respectively Judge at the Challenge Cup 2012 in the Hague (Novice Men/Short Program).

Following consideration of the alleged violations of the General Regulations and the ISU Code of Ethics, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on May 22, 2012, rendered the following decisions:

Hege ROSTO JENSEN is reprimanded and warned to not engage in similar conduct in the future which conduct will cause a more severe sanction.

Lise ROSTO JENSEN is suspended for one (1) year only in her function as Referee for International Competitions in Figure Skating – not in her function as ISU Judge - for violation of the above stated Conflict of Interest Rules and Regulations.

The suspension for one year shall begin with the last date of the Event, March 11, 2012.

All parties shall bear their own costs.

The decisions are subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) as per Article 24, paragraph 12 and Article 25 of the ISU Constitution 2010.
