## **DECISION OF ISU DISCIPLINARY COMMISSIOM**

On August 23, 2019, the ISU filed a complaint against Ms. Alexandra Koshevaia, a Figure Skater of the Figure Skating Federation of Russia for an alleged ISU Anti-Doping Rule violation.

Following consideration of the alleged ISU Anti-Doping Rule violation, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on October 8, 2019 taken its decision:

## **Decision**

"The ISU Disciplinary Commission rules as follows:

- 1. Alexandra KOSHEVAIA is declared responsible for an Anti-Doping violation, committed on March 7, 2019, at the 29<sup>th</sup> Winter Universiade in Krasnoyarsk, Russia.
- 2. A period of ineligibility of two (2) years, beginning on March 7, 2019 and ending on March 6, 2021, is imposed on Alexandra KOSHEVAIA.
- 3. The Figure Skating Federation of Russia must reimburse the ISU for the costs of these proceedings and the laboratory fees of the Anti-Doping testing.
- 4. The skater Alexandra KOSHEVAIA bears her own costs."

The decision of the Disciplinary Commission is published in full on the ISU website.

This decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), as per Article 25 Paragraph 12 and Article 26 of the ISU Constitution 2018.
