Decisions of the Council

The ISU Council met on April 8, 2021 via an online meeting. The following were among the decisions taken by the Council during the meeting.

1. Challenger Series Figure Skating events season 2021/22

The Council approved the Challenger Series Figure Skating Calendar for the season 2021/22 as follows:
