REGULATIONS

The ISU World Speed Skating Championships (Allround & Sprint combination) 2024 will be held in accordance with the 2022 Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and relevant ISU Communications, in particular ISU Communication No. 2591.

Participation in the Championships is open to Skaters who belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 1) that has been allocated quota place(s) for the Championships, and who have met the qualification criteria according to Rule 208 and ISU Communication No. 2591.

TRACK

Max Aicher Arena is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 25 and 29 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is 4 meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective inflatable padding system will be installed around the track.

TITLE AND AWARDS

The winners of the Championships are the Skaters with the lowest total of points after 4 distances have been completed (Rule 265, paragraph 2 and 268, paragraph 1).

The winners of the **Sprint Combination** will bear the title: "World Sprint Speed Skating Champion for 2024", and the winners of the **Allround Combination** will bear the title: "World Allround Speed Skating Champion for 2024" (Rule 133, paragraph a), and will each be awarded the ISU Championships "gold" medal. The Skaters placed second and third in the final classification of each combination after 4 distances will be awarded the ISU Championships "silver" and "bronze" medals, respectively.

Prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2516, or any further update of this Communication.

ENTRIES

The entry quotas will be determined partly by the results from the World Speed Skating Championships (Allround & Sprint combination) 2022 and partly by results achieved during the ISU World Cup Speed Skating Competitions #1 to #6 held during the season 2023/24, in accordance with Rule 208, paragraphs 2.2.1, 2.3.1 and ISU Communication No. 2591. The actual entry quotas will be published by the ISU and communicated to the ISU Members concerned in due time before the deadline for final entries.

According to ISU Communication No. 2591 and Rule 208, paragraph 2.3.1, the following ISU Members have been pre-allocated entry quotas for the **Sprint Combination**:

Entries can **only** be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events available at www.isu.org, section Speed Skating or at <http://isu.events/login.php> and respecting the following deadlines:

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication 1628 need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131, 208 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797.

CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

DRAWING

The drawings will be made in accordance with Rules 239 and 240, paragraph 1 to 4. For the last distance of the Allround Combination (5000m Women and 10000m Men) the number of Skaters to qualify will be 8 (Rule 240, paragraph 3.a).

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

LIABILITY

In accordance with the ISU General Regulations (Rule 119), the ISU, Deutsche Eisschnelllauf-Shorttrack-Gemeinschaft e.V. and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with this Championship. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Monday March 4, 2024. Trial starts will be organized on Wednesday March 6, 2024 for Sprint and Friday March 8, 2024 for Allround.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule latest by February 22, 2024. Decisions on changes' request will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

BOARD AND LODGING

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for expenses for board and lodging at the official hotel from lunch on Wednesday, March 6 until lunch on Monday, March 11, 2024 (Rule 137 paragraphs 10 and 14) for all Competitors participating in the Championships (not for the substitutes) and 1 Team leader or coach for each ISU Member. Expenses of other Skaters and officials (i.e. reserves, substitutes, coaches, other team staff members and accompanying persons) other than those mentioned above, and expenses before or after the period mentioned above, will be at their own expense.

Accommodation requests can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

Hotel prices:

Single room for 1 person – € 110,00 including taxes
Double room for 2 persons – € 120,00 including taxes

Single room with full board (meals & drinks) for 1 person - € 180,- including taxes

Cancellation policy:

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from Monday, March 4, 2024 to Monday, March 11, 2024 from and to the International Airport Salzburg (AUT) and/or railway station Traunstein. Team officials who do not travel together with their team cannot be guaranteed this transportation service.

The price of transportation from the Salzburg Airport to Inzell is € 60,00 p.p. one way for maximum 5 persons and from the Traunstein railway station to Inzell is € 30,00 p.p. one way for maximum 5 persons. There is a train connection from Munich Airport through Munich to Traunstein every hour.

A shuttle bus service will be available between the official hotel and the ice-rink from Monday, March 4, 2024. The distance from the hotel to the ice rink is 1.5 km (15 min. to walk).

The Organizing Committee must be informed via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events about the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitors and officials as soon as possible, but at the latest by Sunday, February 18, 2024.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact the Deutsche Eisschnelllauf- und Shorttrack-Gemeinschaft e.V. if you need an invitation letter for the visa. For the invitation letter please submit the following information:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Passport number
- Passport expiration date
- Arrival & Departure date

Please submit all this information to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, in order to have the necessary visas completed in due time.

To facilitate immigration procedures all Event participants (Skaters, Team staff, Officials) need to present a personal invitation letter for the Event on arrival in Germany. Personal information as specified above for Visa application must therefore be submitted to the OC not later than Sunday, February 18, 2024.

The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. A fee of EUR 250 for each extra Team Officials/Federation Officials accreditation must be paid to the Organizing Committee.
